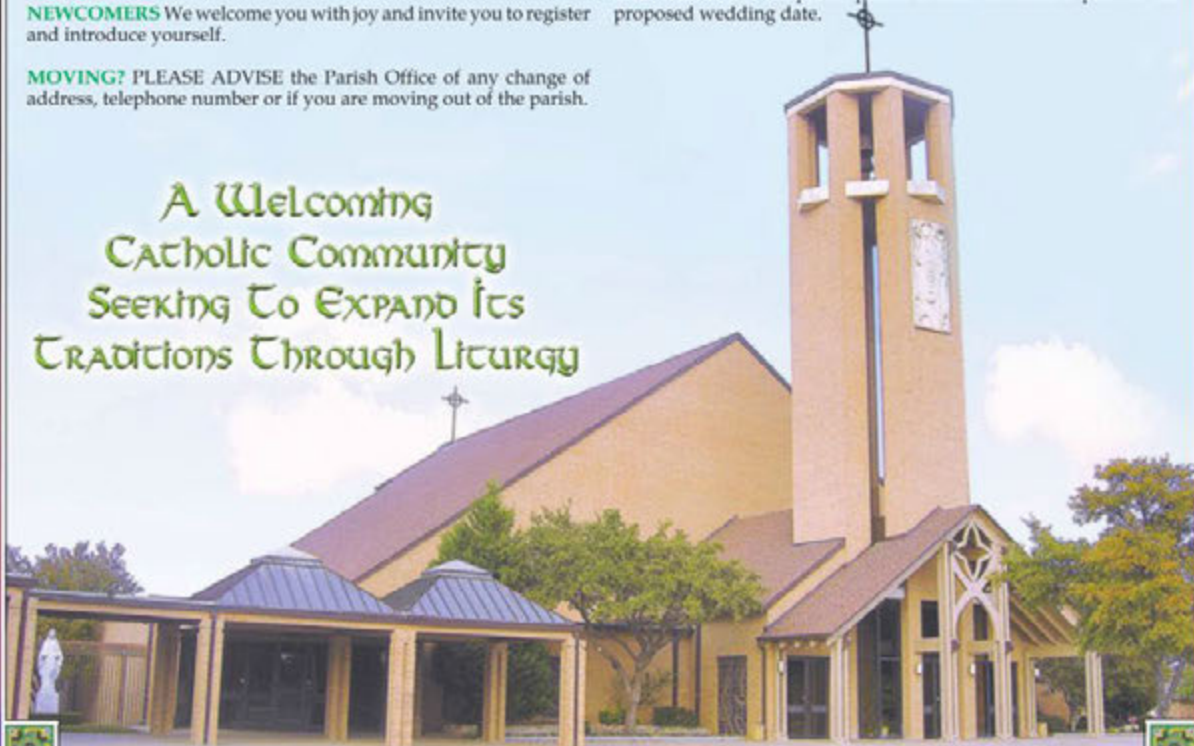

Dear St. Patrick family,

We are members of the Church, the Body of Christ. We not only go to Church, we belong. Belonging to the Church means to participate. For this reason the Church has given us some guidelines to follow. These are the precepts of the Church. They are a description of the **absolute minimum** required of Catholics regarding the Church.

The first precept of the Church is "Attending Mass on **all** Sundays and **Holy Days** of obligation." This precept comes from the third Commandment, "Remember to keep holy the Sabbath, the day of the Lord." God gave this commandment to His chosen people at Mount Sinai. For the Jewish people, the Sabbath begins after sunset Friday evening and ends at sunset Saturday. It is the last day of the week on which God rested after six days of creation (Genesis 2:2). The early Christian community moved the celebration of the Lord's Day to Sunday, the first day of the week. We celebrate the day of the Resurrection of our Lord. We give God the first fruit. To make this day Holy, the fathers of the Catholic Church ask the faithful to keep from doing unnecessary work and to attend Mass. By attending Mass, we give thanks to God for His many blessings. We hear His word. Our Lord comes to us in the Eucharist. We build up the Church, the Body of Christ. We get out of our participation what we put in to it.



Summer time is here. It may be good to review a few points of Church etiquette.

1. Come to Mass on time. We should arrive at least five minutes before the start of Mass to help us to quiet down and be ready to participate.
2. Keep respectful quiet in the presence of our Lord. He is present especially in the Church. We also keep quiet out of respect for the people around us in prayer.
3. Stay to the end of Mass. This means the final blessing and the closing hymn. The final blessing is an important part of the Mass, "We are sent."
4. Turn off the cell phones. If God wants to speak to you personally, He does not need a phone. iPods, MP3 players or such devices, leave them at home or in the car. Texting is not a part of the Mass.
5. Do not bring food or drink, except for medical reasons.
6. Chewing gum in Church, by anyone, Catholic or not, is not appropriate, especially during Mass.
Reasons: a. Respect, b. We break the one hour fast before receiving Communion.
7. Dress appropriately. We attend Mass; this is our participation in the most sacred act. This we proclaim "Christ has died, Christ is risen, Christ will come again." Attending Mass is not being at a picnic, a beach party or a sporting event.
8. Most of all come and actively participate in the prayers, in song and being present to Our Lord, Who is present to us.
